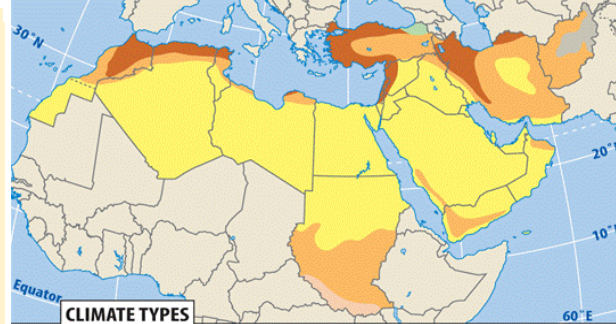
### What are this issues?

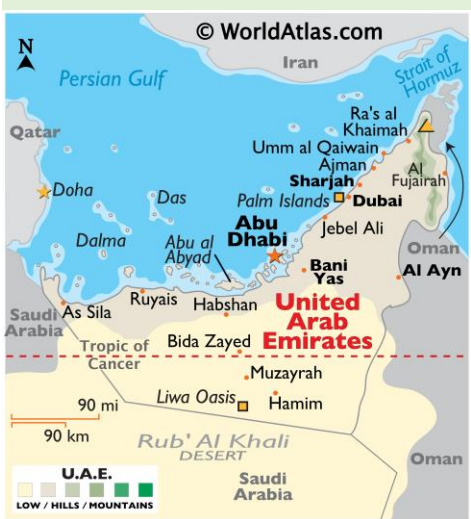
## Saudi Arabia
