

## Grammar Points:

Most adjectives, including colours, come after the noun. The adjective must agree with the noun.



masculine singular	<b>un</b> pull vert
feminine singular	<b>une</b> jupe verte
masculine plural	<b>des</b> polos verts
feminine plural	<b>des</b> chaussures vertes

blanc is irregular:

**un** pull blanc / **une** jupe blanche

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**combien?** how many? / how much?

When followed by a noun, **de** or **d'** is used.



*Il y a combien **de** profs?*

How many teachers are there?

*Il y a combien **d'**élèves?*

How many pupils are there?

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The new **-er** verbs used in exercise 1 all follow the same pattern.



In the present tense, take **-er** off the infinitive and add these endings:

<b>chanter</b>	<b>to sing</b>
<i>je chante</i>	I sing
<i>tu chantes</i>	you sing
<i>il/elle/on chante</i>	he/she sings / we sing
<i>nous chantons</i>	we sing
<i>vous chantez</i>	you (plural or formal) sing
<i>ils/elles chantent</i>	they sing

*Je chante* means 'I sing' or 'I am singing'.
