

## Grammar Points:

**jouer (to play)** is a regular **-er** verb.

<i>je joue</i>	I play
<i>tu joues</i>	you (singular) play
<i>il/elle/on joue</i>	he/she plays / we play
<i>nous jouons</i>	we play
<i>vous jouez</i>	you (plural or polite) play
<i>ils/elles jouent</i>	they play

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**faire** is an irregular verb. It often translates as 'to do'.

<i>je fais</i>	I do
<i>tu fais</i>	you (singular) do
<i>il/elle/on fait</i>	he/she does / we do
<i>nous faisons</i>	we do
<i>vous faites</i>	you (plural or polite) do
<i>ils/elles font</i>	they do

You also use *faire* to describe the weather.  
*Il fait beau / chaud / froid.*

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Use **aimer** (to like), **adorer** (to love) and **détester** (to hate), plus the **infinitive** of another verb, to say what you like or don't like doing.

When used after these verbs, the infinitive translates as 'doing something'.

<i>J'aime regarder ...</i>
<i>J'adore télécharger ...</i>
<i>Je n'aime pas prendre ...</i>
<i>Je déteste faire ...</i>

*J'aime écouter de la musique.* I like **listening** to music.

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Remember:

**Est-ce que tu ...?**      **Do you ...?**  
**Qu'est-ce que tu ...?**      **What do you ...?**

*Est-ce que ...?* questions are usually answered by starting with *oui* or *non*, like 'Do you ...?' questions in English.

**Est-ce que tu aimes faire du judo?**  
**Oui, j'aime faire du judo.**
