The words for 'a', 'some' and 'many' in Spanish are:

	a/an	some	many/a lot of
masc	un museo	unos museos	muchos museos
fem	una tienda	unas tiendas	muchas tiendas

Gramática

Querer (to want) is a stem-changing verb. Some people call these 'boot' verbs.

querer to want

quiero	I want	queremos	we want
quieres	you want	queréis	you (plural) want
quiere	he/she wants	quieren	they want

Gramática

You use the near future tense to say what you are going to do.

Use the present tense of the verb ir + a + the **infinitive**.

Voy a jugar ...	I'm going to play...
Vas a bailar ...	You are going to dance...
Va a ser ...	He/She/It is going to be...
Vamos a ver ...	We are going to watch...
Vais a ir ...	You (plural) are going to go...
Van a comer ...	They are going to eat...

Gramática

The verb ir (to go) is an important irregular verb.

ir	to go
voy	I go
vas	you go
va	he/she goes
vamos	we go
vais	you (plural) go
van	they go

Voy al parque.
I go to the park.

¿Vas de compras?
Do you go shopping?
