Further Education



- Further Education (FE) follows on from school. It ranges from studying A-levels to vocational courses learning a skill

T- Levels



- A course which splits into 80% college training and 20% work placement

Higher Education



- This follows on from FE, this can be situated at university or specialist college focusing on academic ability.

Apprenticeships



- Gain real hands-on experience, earn a salary whilst training, skilled professionals mentor you while training

Private Training within an organisation.



- Private training can be government based or private fee funded

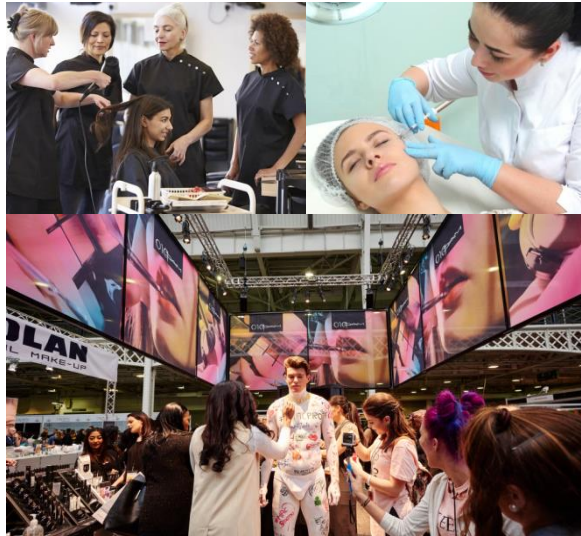
