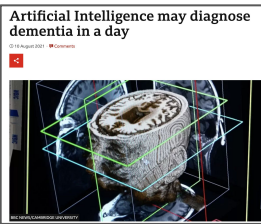
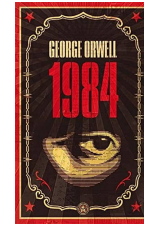


YEAR 9 PHOTOGRAPHY DYSTOPIAN FUTURE

Dystopian

Dystopian refers to an imagined society or state that is bad or unfair. There is often suffering and unfair treatment of people. It often refers to a society of the future, after something terrible has happened.



AI

AI is a machine's ability to perform the cognitive functions we associate with human minds, such as perceiving, reasoning, learning.

The term AI, coined in the 1950s, refers to the simulation of human intelligence by machines.

Photo Manipulation

Photograph manipulation involves the transformation or alteration of a photograph. This can be done physically through collage techniques or using digital manipulation like photoshop.



VIEWPOINT

The viewpoint refers to the position we take the photograph from. The viewpoint can dramatically change the feel of the photograph. Photographing from a low angle will make your subject look taller and more powerful. Photographing from a high angle will shrink your subject and make them appear smaller.

NARRATIVE PHOTOGRAPHY

Narrative photography is the idea that an image or a series of images can be used to tell a story or create a narrative. A narrative is an account of an event or a moment in time, which makes photography the perfect medium for constructing narratives.

CINEMATOGRAPHY

Cinematography is the art of photography and visual storytelling in a motion picture or television show. Cinematography comprises all on-screen visual elements, including lighting, framing, composition, camera motion, camera angles, film selection, lens choices, depth of field, zoom, focus, colour, exposure, and filtration.



DSLR - Digital Single Lens Reflex

The DSLR Camera uses a digital imaging sensor to capture images.

When you push the shutter button on the camera a mirror (That reflects the image in the lens) lifts and the image can then be stored on the memory card.
