You may be aware that the Department for Education announced changes to the relationships and sex education (RSE) for all secondary schools in the UK. These changes came into effect in the summer term, 2021. As previously we will continue to comply with the statutory guidance which can be found here: [Statutory Guidance](#)

The guidance focuses on healthy relationships and keeping children safe in the modern world. It also covers a range of topics relating to physical and mental health, wellbeing and safeguarding. Learning about the emotional, social and physical aspects of growing up gives children the information and positive values to have safe and fulfilling relationships and help them take responsibility for their own wellbeing.

As part of implementing the RSE curriculum we would like to consult with parents and carers to ensure there is a general consensus on our approaches to policy and curriculum content.


