### **Reporting Cycle and Parents Evenings – Key Stage 4 – 2023/2024**

Following on from my communication regarding assessment, I write to inform you of the key dates and processes for reporting home to parents and carers this academic year. **We want to make sure you receive valuable information about your child's progress through reports and parents' evenings.** As mentioned previously, we want the assessments to inform of exactly where your child is, the gaps that need addressing, which will take place through classroom feedback, homework and targeted intervention.

#### **Report content:**

Report Content	Explanation
End of Year 11 Target Grade	The grade your child should be attempting to achieve by the end of their course. Grades 9 – 1 in all GCSE subjects, with the exception of BTEC subjects. BTEC subjects will have a minimum target of Level 2 Pass.
Independent Learning	A score rating your child's independent learning within class on a scale of 1 to 5 with 1 being the best outcome.
Engagement	A score rating your child's engagement within class on a scale of 1 to 5 with 1 being the best outcome.
Predicted Grade	The grade your child is predicted to gain at the end of their course. This is based on: their current level of work; their teacher's professional judgement as to their likely progression and them continuing their current level of effort.
Current Grade	The grade your child is currently working at. This is based on their current level of work.
Percentage Attendance	The consequence of good attendance at school is often that students make expected or better progress. Sadly, the consequence of poor attendance is often that students underachieve as a result. We expect our students to maintain attendance at 96% or over throughout the year.
