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### Year 8 Assessment

Dear Parent/Carer

#### How is my child's work and progress assessed at Victory?

We have decided to change our assessment policy to ensure that children and their families are well informed of when formal tests will take place.

We want to make sure assessments are spiraled, covering content from previous learning that will assess both knowledge and skills. By doing this we hope that your child can prepare in advance, you are able to support at home, therefore making the process more valuable for everyone.

Once the data is captured, staff will have a feedback week where misconceptions are addressed both individually and collectively. Through our diagnostics, we can then put the appropriate interventions in place to help children cement their understanding, so they do not fall behind.

There will be three formal assessment points for English, Science and Mathematics throughout the year. All remaining subjects will have two formal assessment points throughout the year, where staff will inform individual groups of when these assessments will take place and the format. They will also make sure you are informed via Class Charts.

#### The first formal assessment for Year 8 will take place:

- Science on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December
- Mathematics on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> December
- English on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> December

Other subjects will carry out their key formal assessments over a two-week period. Staff will inform individual groups of when these tests will take place. They will also make sure you are informed via Class Charts.

#### Preparing for assessments –What can I do?

- Complete all homework set by the teachers.
- Revise using the new assessment journals. These will be available on our website from October.
- Scan QR codes in planners for [knowledge organisers](#) (or click on the link provided)
- Attend homework club.
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As mentioned above, these are the formal assessment points, but lots of informal assessments will take place in the classroom daily, through questioning, low stakes quizzes, live marking, homework and from work completed in exercise books.

**Report 1 with assessment data will be sent to parents in January.** Students will receive their percentages from teachers as they are marked and should communicate with you.
