**RE: End of Year KS3 Activities Day** 

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware we have a ready, reasonable, and respectful behaviour policy here at Ormiston Victory and as part of the social curriculum that is delivered we ensure that students have the opportunities, daily, to be successful and make the right decisions. Over the last academic year students in Key Stage 3 have been given an enrichment passport in each group that links with our social curriculum. For students that have attended form frequently and engaged with our enrichment programme and the wider community we would like to celebrate their successes and reflect on their hard work and effort this year. On Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> July KS3 will have the opportunity to attend our Activities Day. Our Enrichment Coordinator Mrs. Webb has been working hard with our year teams to ensure that students will have a range of activities to spend their Visa points on, if invited to the end of year celebrations.

## Here is the structure of the day:

Form time - Tutors to hand out Visa point cards for students to spend during form time on Tuesday morning

Period 1 – Lessons as normal

Period 2 - Year 7 activities. Students attend their normal period 2 lesson, register with their timetabled teacher, and then are brought to the DT/ Sports Hall area to attend the event

Period 3 - Year 8 activities. Students attend their normal period 3 lesson, register with their timetabled teacher, and then are brought to the DT/ Sports Hall area.

Period 5 - Year 9 activities. Students attend their normal period 5 lesson, register with their timetabled teacher, and then are brought to the DT/ Sports Hall area.

During the event students will have access to: live music and dance, glitter face art, friendship braclet making, fizzy drinks, inflatables and outdoor activities such a football and crazy golf to spend their Visa points on. If students wish to bring in money there will also be two ice cream vans as well as a sweet company present on the day for them to purchase items from.

It is our intention to ensure that all students that have put in the effort this year will be celebrated and join our staff and year team during this end of year Activities Day. This is a privilege for those that have been successful and they will be rewarded with a non-uniform day for their celebration event. If the year team believe students have not been successful during lesson and social time they will remain in the main building with a member of the Senior Leadership Team during this time. It is our intention to ensure students have the opportunities to be noticed for their enrichment and achievements inside and outside the classroom and we look forward to celebrating.
