


The key ingredients to a successful mime:

- Precision (mime placement, putting mimed objects down instead of letting them vanish, remembering doors and tables etc)
- Speed Your mime should be slowed down and not rushed.
- Exaggeration You will need to exaggerate your body language to make your actions clear.

Slapstick is a style of comedy that involves silly humour (falling over, slipping on banana skin slapping someone with a wet kipper etc but never any nasty violence. The name slapstick comes from an object made of wood which makes a loud smacking sound - a slapstick!

The 5 Key skills for this unit.



A camera shot that involves no speaking and the reaction of one actor to the actions of another an important part of comedy. Some reaction shots are called 'the slow burn' - This is when the reaction builds up in intensity.





A cliff hanger is the term used in drama when the story ends dramatically without coming to a conclusion and the audience is left on the edge of their seat wondering what is going to happen next/left in suspense.



Melodrama is a genre of drama which contains over the top plots and exaggerated characters. These 'stock' characters are recognisable through their actions and gestures. Some stock characters are the hero, villain, damsel in distress, the villain's sidekick.

Silent Movie Stars



Charlie Chaplin (1889-1977) - A comic actor and also filmmaker and composer. Films include 'The Tramp' and 'The Kid'.

Buster Keaton (1895-1966 - Known for his 'physical comedy' and his dead pan expression. He was also a director.

Silent Movies Origins

The earliest silent movies came about in the early 1920's. Technology was not advanced enough for add spoken dialogue. Music matching the emotion or feel of each scene would accompany the film, it was often played live and improvised. 'Intertitles' were used to narrate the story line and present key dialogue.
