

Well done, Ruby! In PE she is such a positive role model always helping others, and what a cracking footballer - she's made the Norfolk U14 School Girls' squad this season!












These skills will be used again by students in further school practical experiments and hopefully in their future STEM careers.












Our Year 8 scientists exploring flower parts!
