#### **Dear Parents and Carers**

It's been another busy fortnight at Victory with much to celebrate.

I was lucky enough to join the Classics GCSE and A Level students this week on their trip to the British Museum to study artefacts relevant to their course. It was an excellent learning experience - and always a joy to visit the capital city on a crisp, sunny autumn day. The more senior students were able to teach Year 10 what they have covered, so there was a great sense of team learning too.

A large group of lucky students will be attending a showing of Hamilton at the Theatre Royal next week - these great £10 tickets have come as part of our ongoing relationship with the theatre. We believe every child should be able to visit their local theatre and have access to affordable seats. Rehearsals have also begun for Charlie and the Chocolate Factory which will be on in December this year - we can't wait to see it.

Our wonderful students, many of whom are our lovely new Year 7s, participated in our first session for the Care Home Choir with Friend in Deed - they did a great job and brought smiles to many older folks via the blessing of technology in several local care homes.

We loved hosting our annual Open Evening and welcomed in many visitors - we also have our Sixth Form Open event on Thursday 9th October from 5pm. This is



aimed at current Year 11 students, but if keen Year 10s also want to attend, they are most welcome. This event is open to any student considering where to go for Sixth Form, not just Victory's young people. We have around 30% of our Year 12 cohort from other schools, which is great - it's healthy for young people to meet new friends and make new connections.



We are working as a teaching team to support even better progress and achievement for our pupils by asking them to 'Elevate It' in lessons - to keep trying to improve their initial answers to get to the top grades. We have also invested in several 'visualisers' which your children may refer to - these help to watch staff who can give a 'live model' of how to respond to tasks - research shows us that more demonstrations of success help children to grow in confidence when they tackle questions themselves.

Our school, and Lord Nelson Sixth Form which is part of Victory, has partnered again with the local organisation, Nelsonspirit. This means we will benefit from careers support for Sixth Form students and the opportunity for Year 12 students to express an interest in the Lord Lieutenant's Norfolk Future Leaders Crew. This is a great opportunity to walk with Norfolk's major business leaders and meet other young leaders from other Norfolk schools. The programme requires young people to:

- Serve and Grow complete 3 to 6 months of voluntary service within an organisation of their choice (this can be done at Victory)
- Meet and Mentor take part in the Norfolk crew meetings and make great connections (please note that successful applicants would need to organise their own transport to and from the events)
- Muster and Celebrate meet with other future leaders and the Lord Lieutenant at the Royal Norfolk Show

The deadline for applications is Friday 25th October 2025 - the form will be available soon. I would welcome the opportunity to talk to Year 12s who are interested and to tell them about Matthew who completed the programme this year - and was so

impressive that he is now the Business Manager for Nelsonspirit!






