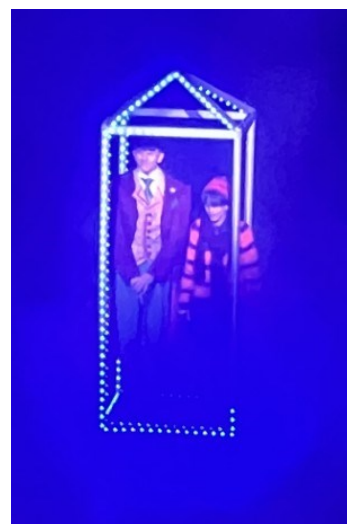


Dear Parents and Carers,

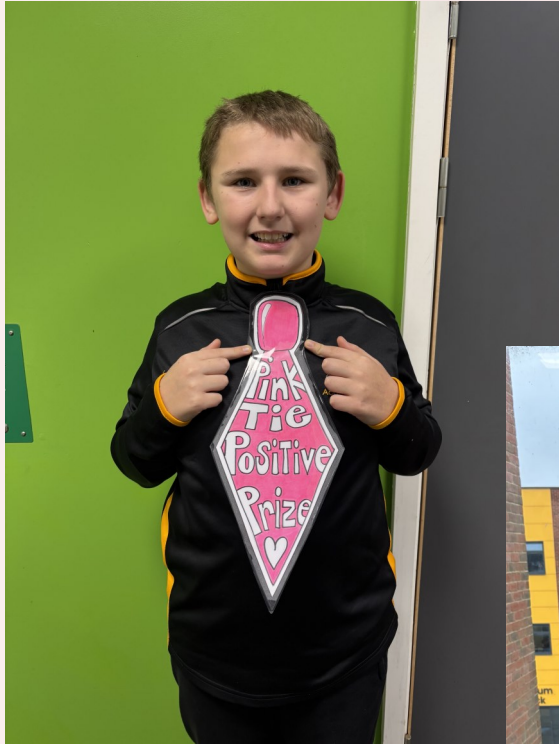

Year 7 Pink Tie Positivity @ Victory

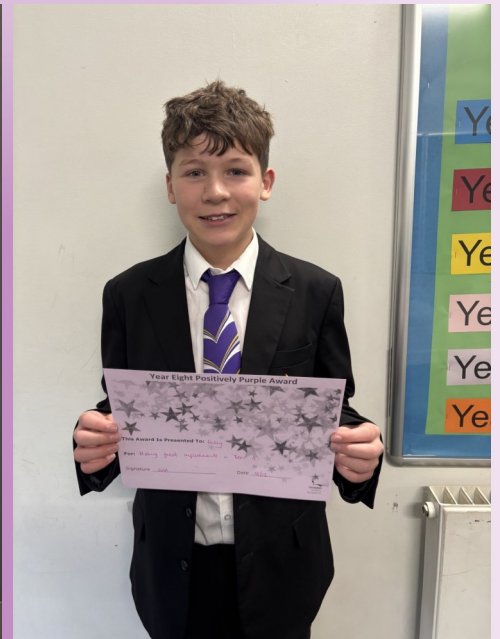

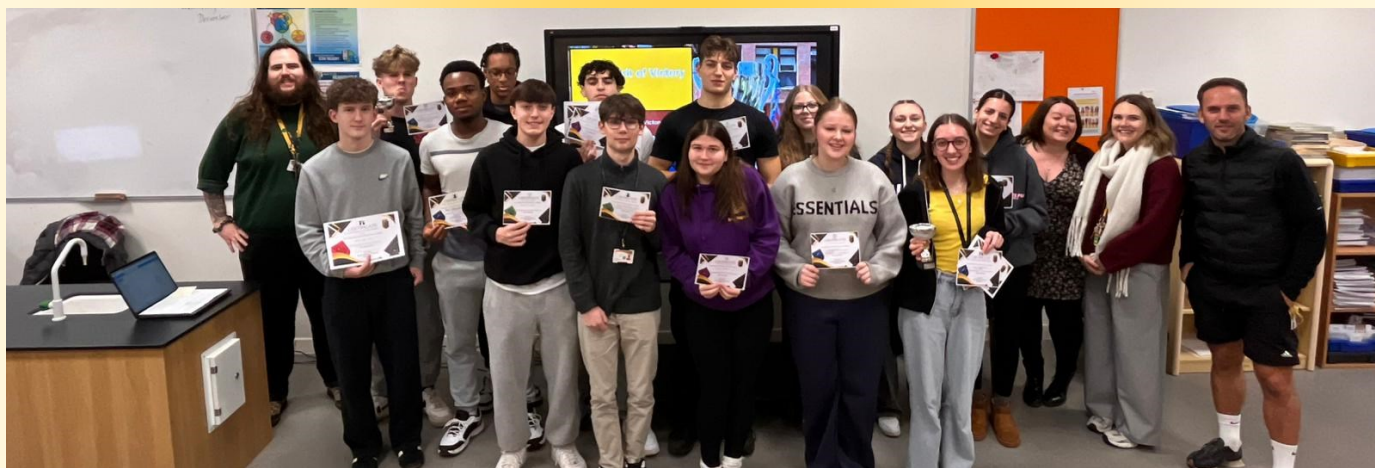

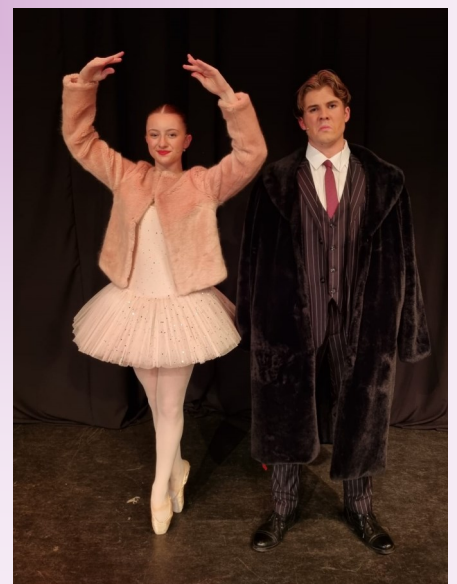
