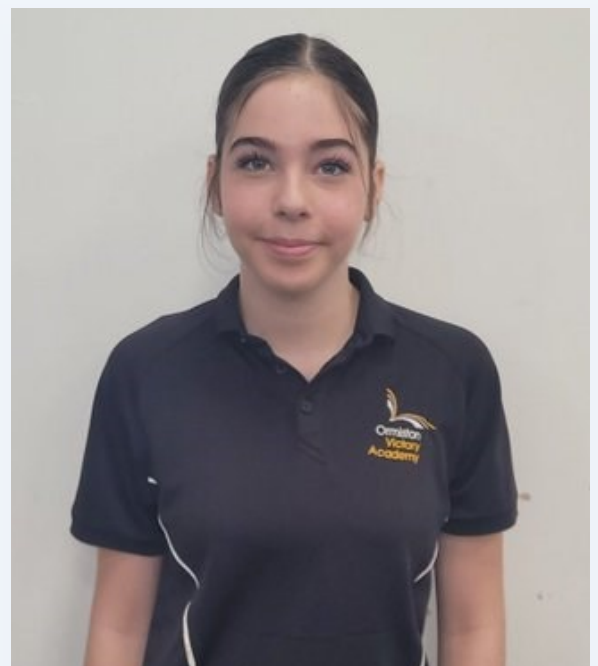

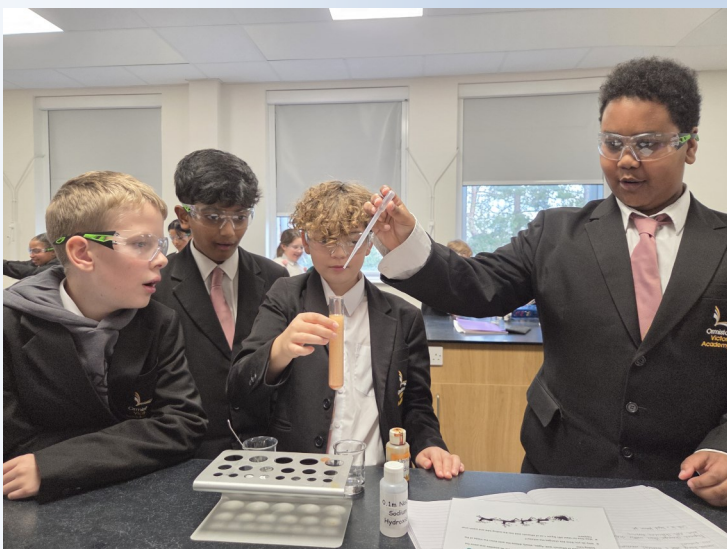
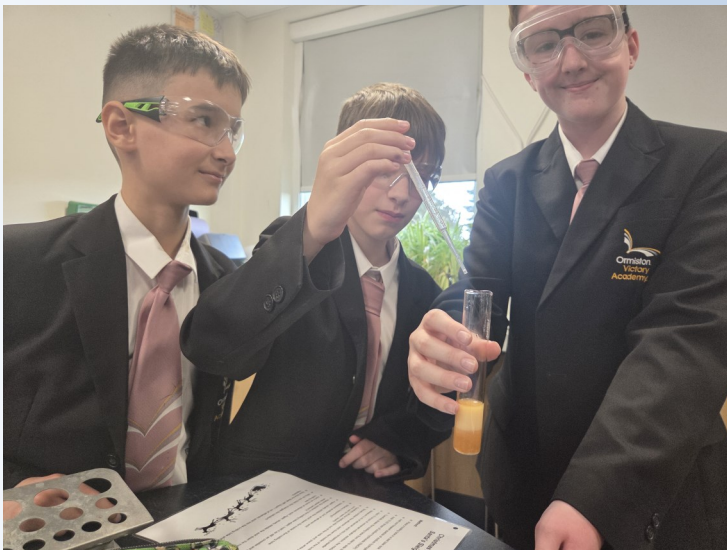

Beautiful work by Emily in Y7 responding to the paintings of Jenny Saville using oil pastel and pen.



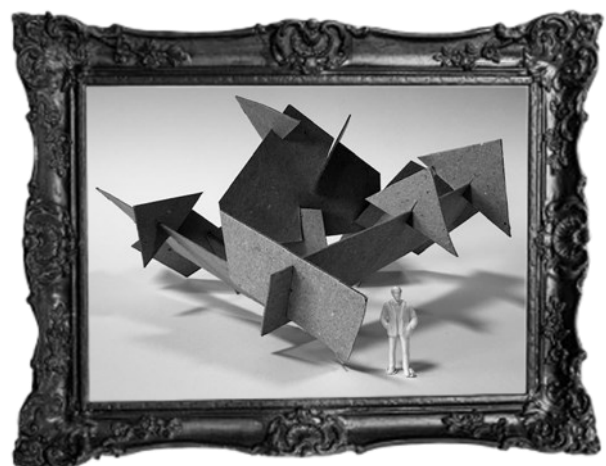
Olo in Y10 has produced some stunning portraiture pieces exploring dry point etching and acrylic paint.



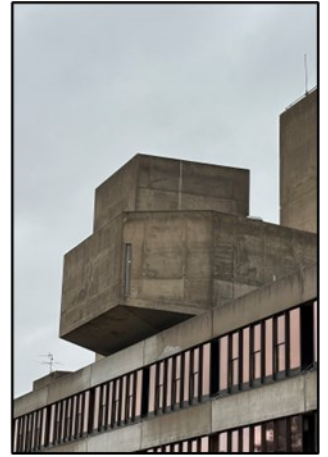
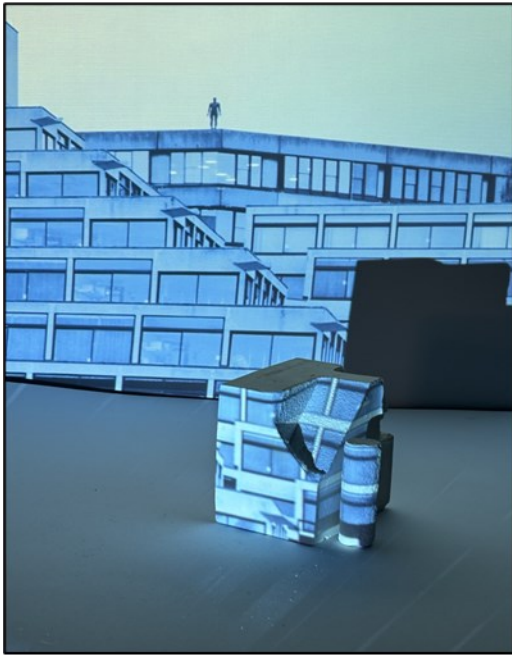
Henry in Y10 has explored still life and has made these delicate water colour and etching pieces - wonderful work!
