Thank you for your support, as ever.

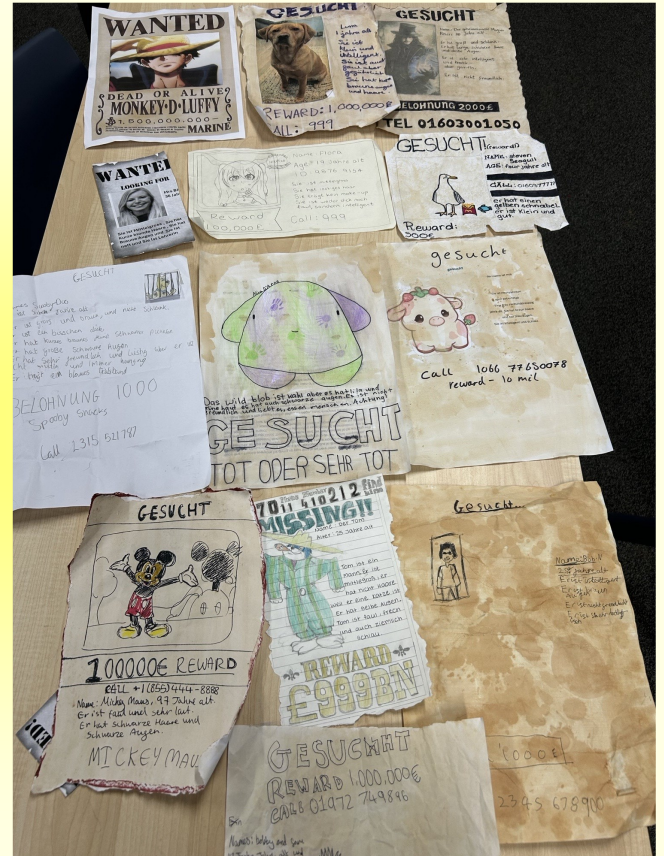

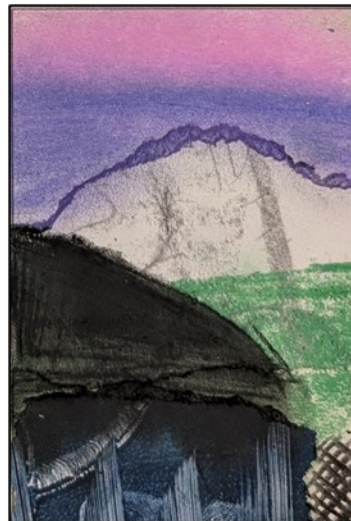

Y9 have developed their understanding of abstraction and oil pastel in these lovely landscape studies.

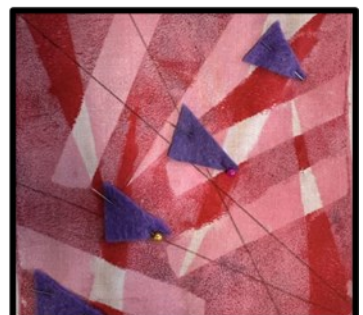

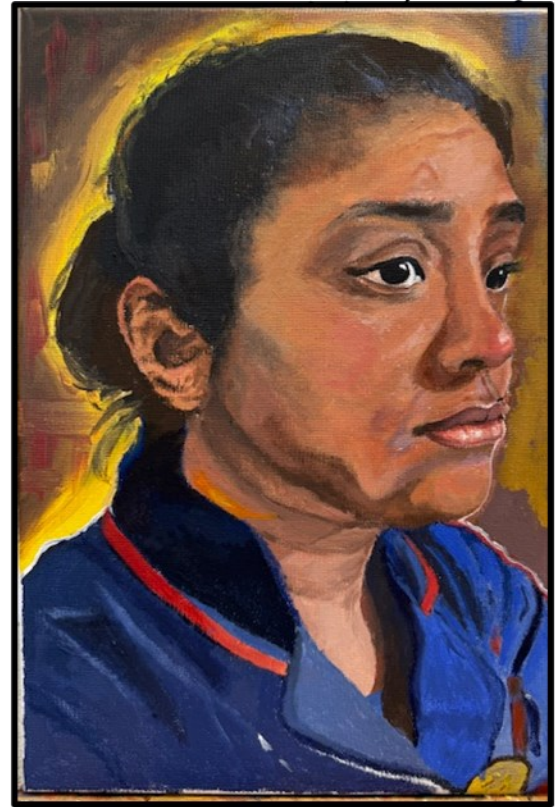
