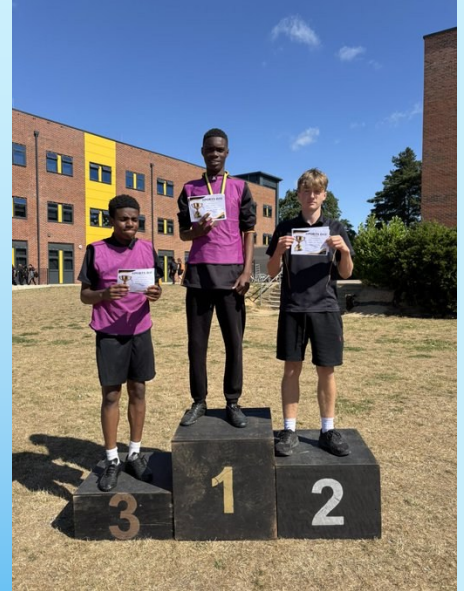

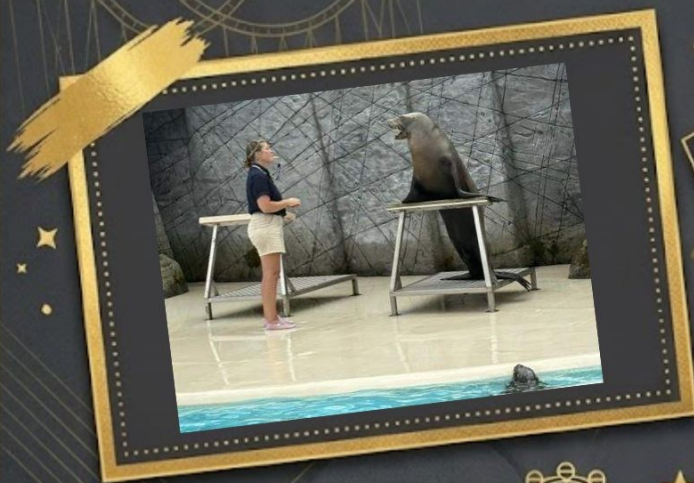

UNIVERSITY CLEARING

WHAT IS CLEARING?

Clearing is how unis and colleges fill any places they still have on their courses.

From 2nd July – 19th October 2026, you can apply for a course using Clearing, if you're not already holding an offer from a university or college, and the course still has places.

WHEN CAN YOU USE CLEARING?

- you're applying after 30 June
- you didn't receive any offers (or none you wanted to accept)
- you didn't meet the conditions of your offers
- you've declined your firm place using the 'decline my place' button in your application

If you're applying through Clearing on results day (13th August), you can add your choice in your UCAS Hub account. Visit UCAS for more info:

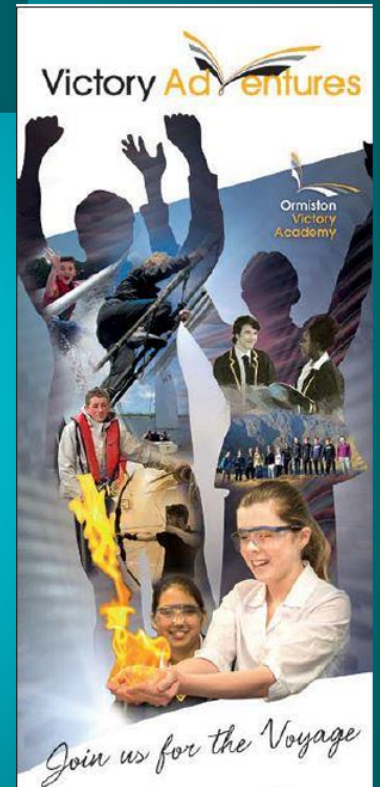

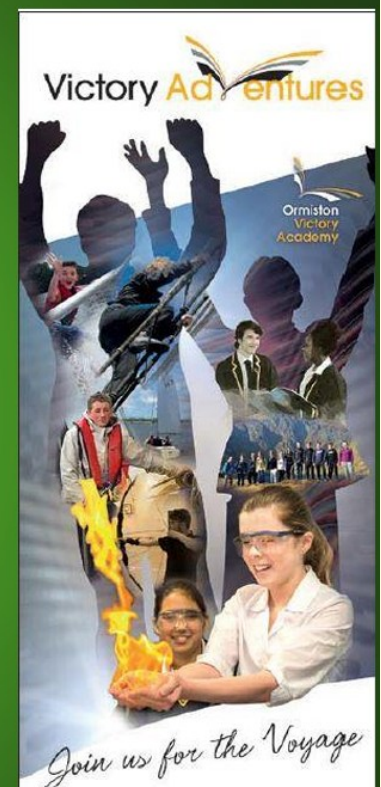

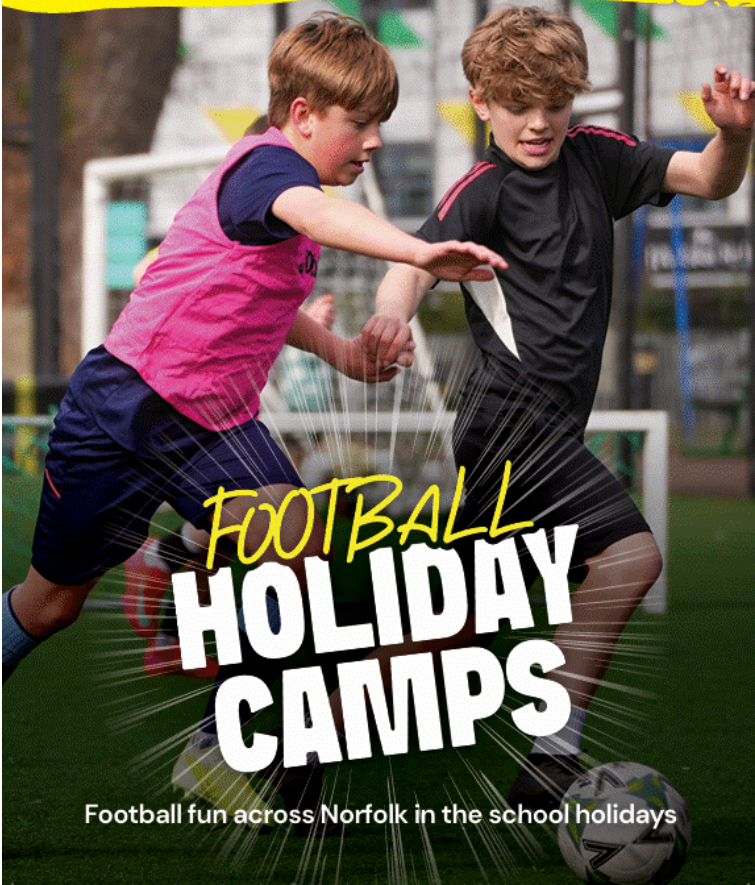
